Affordable housing providers are organizations that own or manage properties with rents set at reduced rates, typically based on your income, household size, and county Area Median Income (AMI). Many also accept housing vouchers and offer supportive services to help residents maintain stability.

They employ supportive service coordinators who work with residents to understand their needs and deliver trauma-informed services to ensure the wellbeing, health, and self-sufficiency of residents.

Based on openings; some waitlists apply

Boulder Housing Partners, Boulder's housing authority, provides affordable apartment homes with below-market rents, rental assistance, and supportive services designed to ensure residents' health and stability. Eligibility is based on income, student status, and other requirements, with waitlists managed by individual properties.

Statewide (properties across Colorado)

ACCEPTS VOUCHERS:

Some listed properties accept vouchers

INCOME REQUIREMENTS:

Varies by property; most serve households earning 30–60% of AMI

AVAILABILITY:

Many listed properties are currently available

Metro West Housing Solutions, which began as Lakewood's housing authority, develops, owns, and manages affordable housing communities for families and senior citizens in both Lakewood and Denver. Their mission is to provide quality housing and strengthen neighborhoods by overseeing mixed-income properties, administering Housing Choice Vouchers, and offering resident services that support individuals, families, and communities. They maintain active waitlists on all properties, which interested tenants must join to access housing units as they become available.

MISSION SUPPORTS

Mission Supports assists Denver residents with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) experiencing housing instability navigate the disability benefits system to access the right supports and pursue a future away from homelessness.
